- a more attractive exterior
- improvement to stall spaces

Plans also feature improvements to Barrow's transport infrastructure, such as:

- demolishing vacant buildings to create better links between the Market Hall and the high street
- upgrades to pedestrianisation
- creating new bus stops

The award from the Levelling Up Fund will build on the package of projects funded by the £25 million Town Deal for Barrow.
